How do you preferred to be paid?

Is there a cash discount or is there a credit card fee?

Do you have a contract?

What is the deposit?

When is final payment due?

How do you handle substitutions if flowers are bad or don't come in?

Do you offer additional rental services? If so what is the rental policy.

How often will we meet?

How late can changes or additions be made?

Do you coordinate with the cake baker?

Do you offer floral preservation or pressing?
